We are nearing the end of the Season of Lent. I hope that it has been a fruitful time of reflection and repentance. I hope that you feel "lighter" at the end of this journey. Easter Sunday is such a wonderful time of celebration. Our God, the Almighty God, turned the world upside down. Just when it seemed that all hope was lost, hope was fully alive and well in the resurrected Jesus. The emptiness of death was replaced with an empty tomb.

Easter indeed changes everything!

Join us on Easter Sunday as we celebrate our risen Savior and as we celebrate the promise of eternal life through Him. Our choir will have several special songs for us that day. It will be a day of Joy and Hope.

Before Easter gets here we still have to make our way to the cross. Palm Sunday begins the final stage of that trek. Our children will begin the service by bringing in the palms. It will be a bittersweet day as it starts the week off in celebration before it ends in sorrow.

On Thursday, Maundy Thursday, you will be able to stop by the church and

take communion. Maundy Thursday is the day we remember the first communion that took place in the Upper Room. Between the hours of 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM you can take communion in the sanctuary. I will bless the bread and juice that morning and leave instructions. I will not be serving you, this will be just you and the Lord. You are welcome to stay as long as you like and reflect. If you want, you can also bring your nail that day and hammer it to the cross.

The next day on Good Friday we will have a special service of shadows and darkness as we remember the crucifixion of Jesus. You can also bring your nail that night, if you didn't on Thursday, and nail it to the cross. There will be a time in the service you can do that.

God bless you and thank you for going on this journey through Lent.
